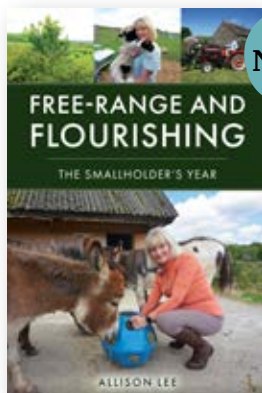

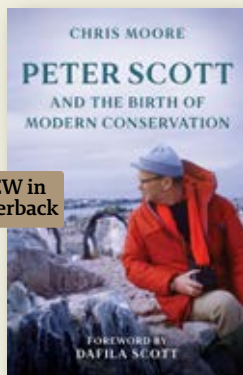

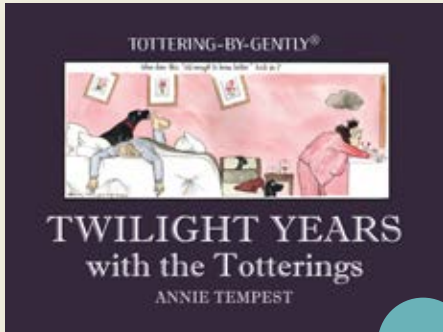


Peter Scott and the Birth of Modern Conservation
